The Nursing and Allied Health faculties regularly organize field visits and student wellness programs that incorporate educational sessions into their health awareness days. The programs include material distribution and expert workshops, along with confidential counseling services to support students. The university's initiatives in sexual and reproductive health education and access directly implement Sustainable Development Goal 3 (Good Health and Well-being) while establishing reproductive health education for everyone. The health-related inclusive education aligns with Sustainable Development Goal 4 (Quality Education), and the empowerment of women and girls through reproductive choice aligns with Sustainable Development Goal 5 (Gender Equality). The university forms partnerships with various health organizations and government departments to advance Sustainable Development Goal 17 (Partnerships for the Goals) through collaborative institutional relationships. A wide array of compassionate projects illustrates BAU's commitment to an institutional culture centered on informed body sovereignty and sustainable reproductive rights for its student community.

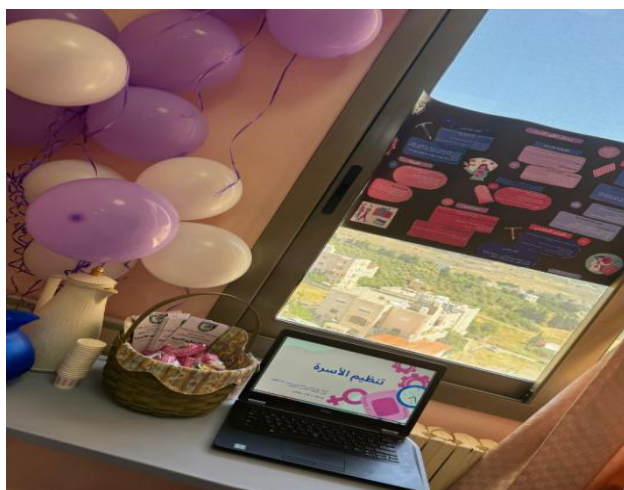
