The following initiatives, activities, training programs, events, and workshops are organized by students.

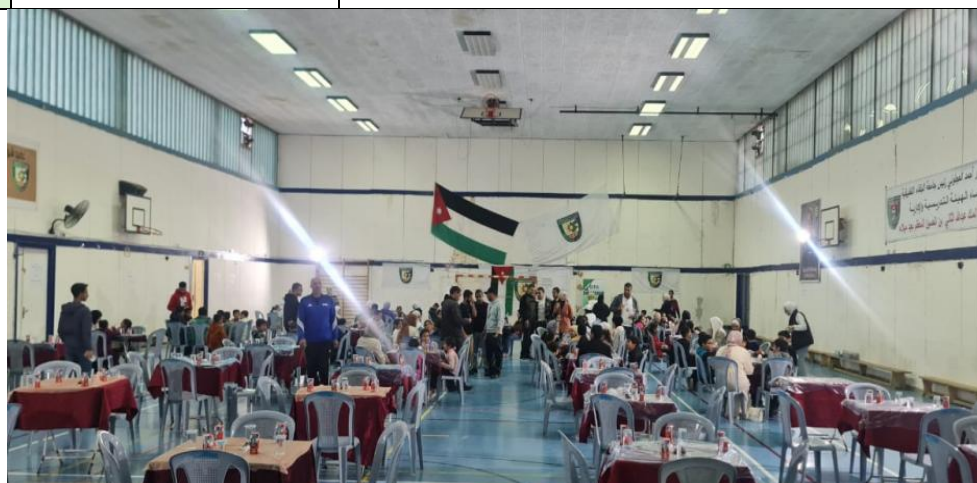

Initiative of “Cleaning Abandoned Heritage Houses in As-Salt City Purpose of the initiative:

The initiative combines academic education, practical application, community service, spread the awareness, saving heritage buildings, adaptive reuse and achieving SDGs.



Dr. Maisa Al-Shomali, a professor in the Architecture Department, specialized in cultural heritage conservation, is conducting a voluntary initiative with university students concerned with cleaning abandoned heritage buildings, documenting, and trying to find an investor to restore and adaptive reuse the building with an appropriate function. To carry out this initiative, cooperating with local community partners: (As-Salt Municipality, Architectural Youth Initiative "Fikra" (founded by Dr. Shomali in 2020 for young architects and students), and As-Salt Charity Association). The initiative started in 2023 with "Said Al-Bahra School", and in 2024 with Hattar house, both buildings have high value and are located in Al-Jada heritage area, unfortunately full of haberdashery, herbs and rodents.

- * The municipality made sure of Civil Defense existing for safety.

Students, youth architects of Fikra and the municipality workers, cleaned the buildings, removed all scrap and dirt, and mop the floors until the tiles appeared and uprooted harmful plants from the stone walls and cleaned it completely.

- * Students documented the buildings; drew drawings, interviewed with old people who had memories with the buildings for interpretation and intangible heritage, told the story of the place and its history from various written and oral sources. The budget was zero, that all parties supported in logistics and the owner served food.

- * Things are currently underway to arrange the operation of the building and its reuse, under follow up.

- * Work is currently underway to clean up another valuable heritage building with the expansion of the circle of partners after the initiative was well received by the local community.

University of Jordan. The event saw the involvement of all public universities and several private universities, with 44 projects competing across 9 categories. The participation was marked by the presence of Professor Dr. Radwan Dwairi, Dean of the Faculty of Engineering, and Dr. Abeer Hayari, Head of the Department of Electrical Engineering. In this prestigious competition, the students from the Faculty of Engineering at BAU secured second place in the category of "Technologies for Smart Cities and Quality of Life" for their innovative project titled **‘Smart Home for People with Disabilities Based on Sign Language Recognition’**. This project, supervised by Dr. Abeer Hayari, exemplifies BAU's commitment to addressing societal challenges through technological innovation.

The university emphasizes sustainability and community service in its projects, encouraging students to actively engage in initiatives that benefit both society and the environment. This recognition highlights BAU's dedication to producing impactful, real-world solutions that contribute to the well-being of communities, particularly by enhancing the quality of life for individuals with disabilities.

Smart Agriculture project:



The Smart-Agriculture initiative, funded by the Inter-Islamic Network on Water Resources Development and Management (INWRDAM), serves as a dedicated training centre for local farmers and agricultural students. This initiative aims to disseminate knowledge from the campus to farms across the region. In the past year, the Faculty of Agriculture Technology successfully offered a series of courses in smart organic agriculture to 500 students. These courses covered a range of subjects, including Hydroponics techniques, the impact of climate on smart agriculture, as well as GIS and remote sensing applications in agriculture and sustainable agriculture.

In addition, within the framework of the Smart Desert Project, both male and female students from the Faculty of Agriculture Technology participate in specialized training centered around smart agriculture. This program emphasizes the utilization of Internet of Things (IoT) applications in agricultural practices. It is notable that these training sessions take place at the Agricultural Business Incubator located within the National Agricultural Research Institute.

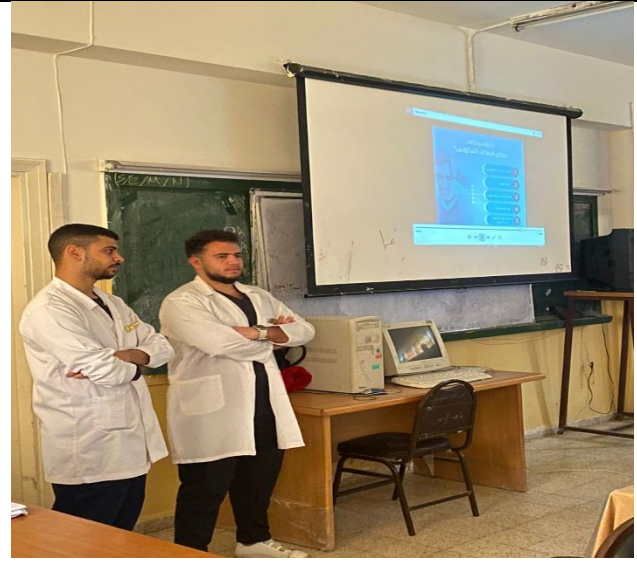
