### BAU and ICOMOS Jordan Sign an MoU to Strengthen the Conservation and Management of Cultural Heritage

The International Council on Monuments and Sites – Jordan (ICOMOS Jordan) and Al-Balqa Applied University signed, at the headquarters of the Bayt Ya'ish Cultural Center, a memorandum of understanding aimed at strengthening joint cooperation in the conservation and management of cultural heritage, scientific research, training, and capacity building, with a focus on integrating modern technologies, foremost among them artificial intelligence, in a manner that contributes to advancing knowledge and professional practices in Jordan's cultural heritage sector.

The memorandum was signed on behalf of ICOMOS Jordan by Her Royal Highness Princess Dana Firas, President of ICOMOS Jordan and UNESCO Goodwill Ambassador for Cultural Heritage, and on behalf of Al-Balqa Applied University by President Dr. Ahmad Fakhri Al-Ajlouni.

This memorandum stems from both parties' commitment to unifying efforts and strengthening the partnership between academic and professional institutions, in a manner that serves the goals of sustainable development and contributes to protecting cultural heritage and preserving it for future generations, alongside keeping pace with the accelerating digital transformation in the heritage sector.

### BAU and Greater Salt Municipality Mark the Kingdom's 80th Independence Day



In partnership with the Greater Salt Municipality, BAU celebrated the eightieth anniversary of the independence of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan in a national ceremony organized by the Deanship of Student Affairs. The event was attended by President Dr. Al-Ajlouni; Mr. Ali Al-Bataineh, Head of the Greater Salt Municipal Committee; Dr. Rami Abu Rumman, Director of the New Salt Hospital; university vice presidents; and members of the local community, faculty, staff, and student body.

President Dr. Al-Ajlouni noted that Independence remains an enduring national milestone through which Jordanians recall the journey of nation-building led by the Hashemites over decades of service, adding that the University draws from the occasion the values of belonging and loyalty it seeks to instill in its students through its national activities and programs.



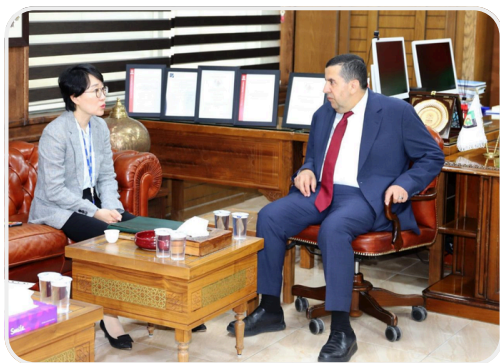
### **BAU and Pearson Sign Partnership to Strengthen Vocational and Technical Training**

BAU has secured a new academic milestone with the full accreditation of its Bachelor of Applied Chemistry program by the Canadian Society for Chemistry, effective from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2033.

President Dr. Ahmad Fakhri Al-Ajlouni described the accreditation as a qualitative addition to the University's academic record, reflecting its sustained efforts to develop its programs in line with the highest international standards and to prepare graduates equipped to compete in local, regional, and international labor markets.

### BAU Hosts the Jordanian-European Research Day for the Central Region

Al-Balqa Applied University hosted the activities of the “Jordanian-European Research Day for the Central Region,” organized by the Higher Council for Science and Technology with the participation of a select group of researchers, academics, and representatives of universities, research institutions, and the private sector across the Central Region, held on the University’s main stage in the city of Salt.

The University affirmed that hosting this event comes in line with the directions of President Dr. Ahmad Fakhri Al-Ajlouni aimed at supporting scientific research and innovation, strengthening the University’s openness to international research institutions, expanding opportunities for cooperation and partnership with global scientific bodies, raising the level of research output, and enhancing the University’s presence and standing in international research programs and projects, in a manner that serves national development priorities and the University’s vision of excellence and leadership.

### BAU Extends Registration for the Comprehensive Examination Until Thursday, 2 July 2026

Al-Balqa Applied University has announced an extension of the registration period for the Comprehensive Examination for the Associate Degree (al-Shamel) for the 2026 summer session, through the end of the working day on Thursday, 2 July 2026, in order to give the largest possible number of students the opportunity to complete their registration procedures.

The University confirmed that registration is carried out through the university colleges and intermediate university colleges at which the student has completed the requirements for passing, in accordance with the instructions approved by the General Evaluation and Examinations Unit. Students who are still enrolled in their studies during the current semester are also eligible to sit the examination.



### **BAU Claims Three Medals at the National University Boxing Championship**



BAU delivered a notable performance at the Jordanian Universities Boxing Championship, hosted by Al-Zaytoonah University with twelve universities competing, claiming three medals across weight categories.

The achievement reflects the University’s continued support for athletics and talented students, under the patronage of President Dr. Al-Ajlouni and the supervision of Dr. Khalaf Fakhri Khatatneh, Dean of Student Affairs. President Dr. Al-Ajlouni said the result reflects BAU’s commitment to supporting and empowering students and to strengthening their presence in sporting arenas in a manner befitting the University’s reputation.

### **BAU Takes First and Third Place at Al-Hussein Fund Water Technology Awards**

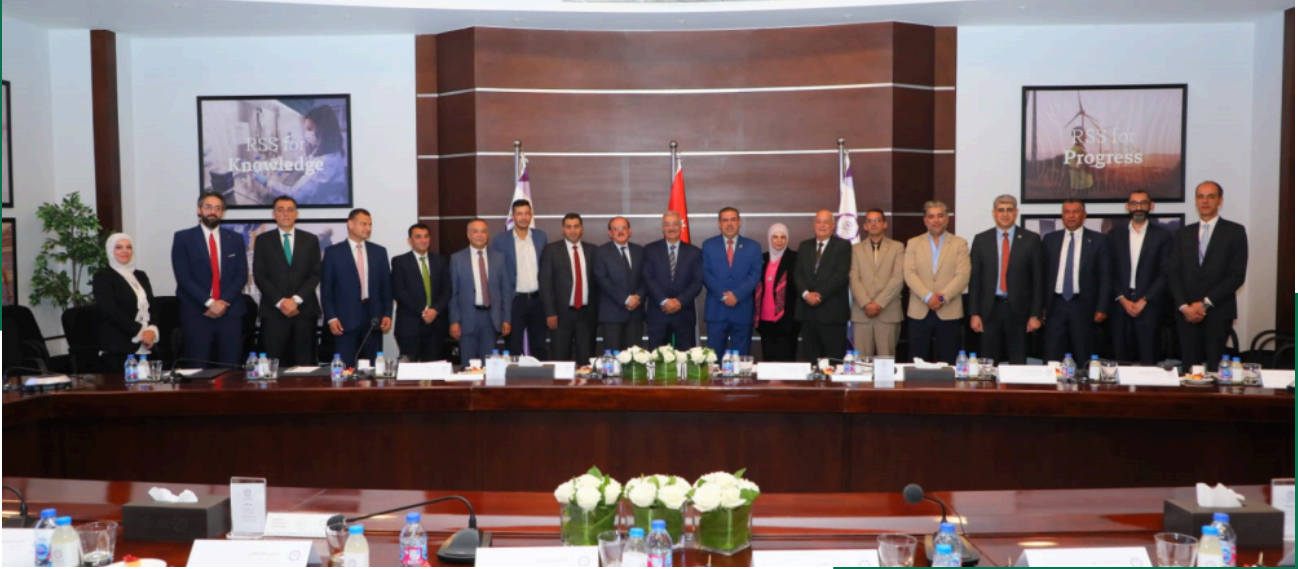

The memorandum covers several areas of cooperation, most notably organizing specialized workshops and providing students with field training and the practical expertise they require.

### Zarqa University College Hosts Course on Digital Financial Services

Zarqa University College organized a training course on “Digital Financial Services in Jordan,” in collaboration with INJAZ/Zarqa, the Central Bank of Jordan, and the Jordan Payments and Clearing Company (JoPACC), with Dean Dr. Zaid Suleiman Al-Adwan in attendance.

Around eighty faculty, staff, and students took part in the intensive program, which covered the key concepts and applications of digital financial services. Delivered interactively by trainers Aya Abbad and Aya Rabee, the course raised awareness of digital financial services, their mechanisms of use, and their importance in supporting financial inclusion and digital transformation in Jordan.

### Water Research Center Joins Regional WEF E Nexus Training Program



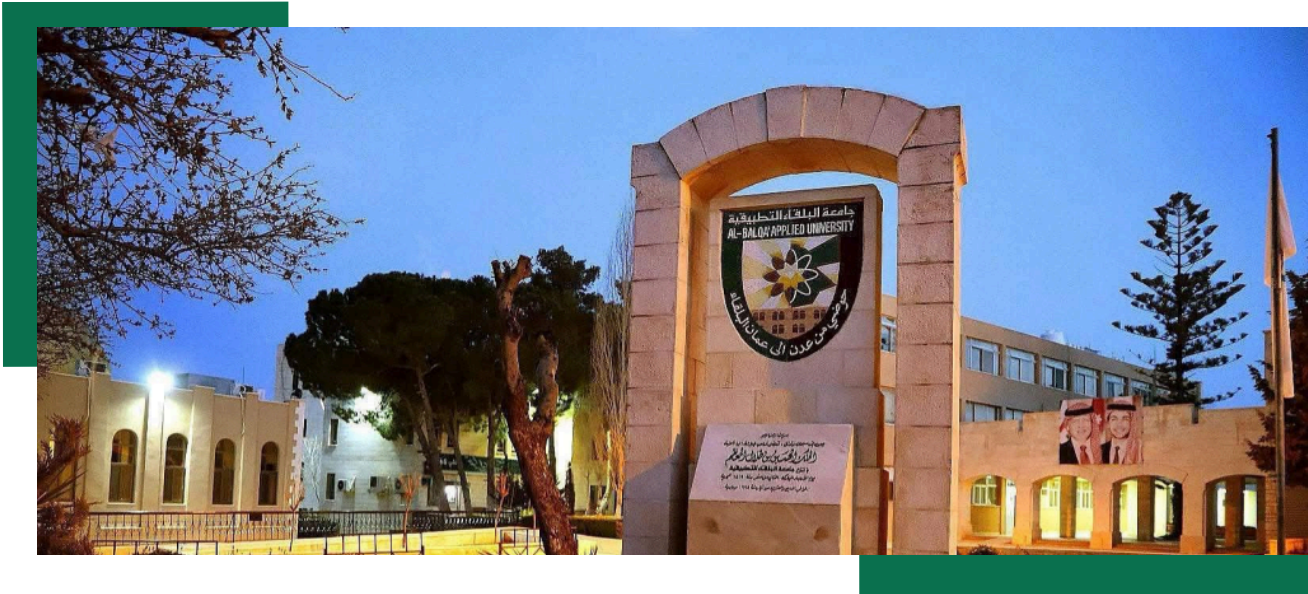

### **BAU Celebrates the Graduation of Participants in the “Anti-Narcotics Aides” Course**

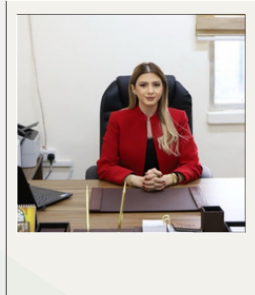
